2016 Annual Meeting Minutes

January 31, 2016 Saint Barnabas on the Desert

Opening – Senior Warden David Getts called the meeting to order. All present joined in singing hymns to open the meeting.

Appointment of Clerk & Approval of 2015 Minutes – A motion was made to appoint Ann Hott as Clerk. The motion was seconded and unanimously approved by voice acclamation. A motion was made to approve the minutes of the 2015 meeting. The motion was seconded and unanimously approved by voice acclamation.

Thank You Announcements – Rector Jim Clark led all present in thanking 2015 Diocesan Convention Delegates and Alternates Sue Dietrich, Tom Dietrich, Joyce Nichols, Nick Nichols, Alex Vinger, Larry Brainard, Bonnie Lebeck, Donna Piscopo, Jim Piscopo and Karen Steckler. Outgoing Vestry members Margaret Beresford, Sean O'Hara and Bruce Williams were also thanked for their service. Linda Killmer as Treasurer, Jon Killmer as Chair of the Foundation were thanked for their continuing service. David Carmichael, outgoing Chancellor, and Tom Hott, outgoing Chair of Buildings and Grounds, were thanked for their service as well.

Nominations and Elections – Sky Larsen, Chair of the 2015 Vestry Nominating Committee, presented nominees selected for Junior Warden, Vestry, and Diocesan Convention Delegates and Alternates.

- For Junior Warden, Carol Okin was placed in nomination to serve a second year as Junior Warden. David asked for nominations from the floor. Hearing none, the vote was called. Carol Okin was unanimously elected by voice acclamation.
- Jim Hoselton was presented as a Vestry nominee for a three year term. Jim had been appointed by the Vestry in 2014 to fill a vacant position, and elected by the parish to a one year term to complete the vacancy in 2015. It was noted that the St. Barnabas Bylaws state that a Vestryperson is not eligible for reelection as a Vestryperson until after the expiration of one (1) year from the date of termination of previous service. David asked for a motion to waive this requirement to allow Jim Hoselton to be nominated. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously by voice acclamation.
- Sky then presented Ann Shannon, Tom Dietrich and Don Bivens as nominees for three-year terms on Vestry. David asked for nominations from the floor. There were none.
- The vote was called. All Vestry nominees were unanimously elected by voice acclamation.
- The following people were nominated as Delegates and Alternate Delegates for the 2016 Arizona Diocesan Convention: As Delegates – Tom Fitzsimons, Donna Piscopo, Jim Piscopo, Karen Steckler and Stephanie Stewart. As alternates, to serve if these Delegates are not able to serve: Tom Baker, Jim Berg, Ellen Shreve, Ken Vegors and Judie Wimmer. David asked for additional nominations from the floor. Hearing none, David asked for a motion to elect the candidates. The motion was made and seconded. The vote was called. All were elected by unanimous voice acclamation.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u> – Treasurer Linda Killmer presented and reviewed the 2015 Financial Overview of operating fund and growth gift fund budgets. The original budget had forecast a deficit of \$59,364. The actual deficit result for the year was \$2,436. The proposed growth gift budget anticipated a year end result of \$1181 remainder. The remainder at end of 2015 was \$57,055.

Senior Warden's Report -

- Five Star Development/Ritz Carlton A plan for development of the property surrounding Saint Barnabas has been approved by the Town of Paradise Valley, including plans for development of a new Ritz Carlton resort. Saint Barnabas is entering an agreement with the owner/developers, Five Star Development, in which Five Star will remove fences and provide new landscaping and irrigation on Saint Barnabas perimeter areas to blend with the new development.
- Campus Capital Needs Committee (CCNC) The CCNC has made an exhaustive inventory of the state of Saint Barnabas campus and buildings, noting items in need of repair or replacement. The assessment has revealed immediate need to replace the music center and book shop/Other Cup roof. The Vestry has opted to borrow funds from a line of credit to pay for these replacements.

Rector's Report -

- <u>Stewardship Report</u> Chairman Bruce Williams and members of the Stewardship Committee were thanked for their service during the fall Stewardship campaign. Jim Clark reported that, as of January 31, Saint Barnabas has received 446 pledges totaling \$1,613,262. Jim thanked the congregation for their generous response. Additional pledges are anticipated.
- **<u>2016 Budget</u>** Jim presented the 2016 Operating Fund budget. Jim noted that a pledge projection of \$1,600,000 is being used for the operating fund budget. Jim noted that with other income there will be \$1.9 million to do Jesus' work. Jim thanked all present.
- <u>Growth Strategy</u> Jim reviewed elements of the 2016 Growth Strategy (copy attached and incorporated herein.) He asked all present to find their place within the strategy. When stating "If it is to be it is up to me," where do they see themselves in the initiatives for Growth? Pictures and testimony were shared. Nick Roosevelt presented a video and information regarding the Saturday night service to begin on February 13.

A period of general discussion and clarifying questions ensued. Support for the plans was voiced. All present joined in applause and gratitude. Discussion ended.

Blessing & Adjournment – Following a blessing by Jim, the meeting adjourned at 1:25 p.m.
